Yes, it is possible to earn “free money”! MCCS has several ways it earns tens of thousands of dollars a year without asking people to buy something they don't truly want. Not everyone can write a check or donate stock, but *everyone* can participate in our free money program.



Giant & Darrenkamp's Gift Cards: These two grocery stores allow MCCS to sell their gift cards at a 10% profit. For each thousand dollars in cards sold, MCCS earns \$100. The school passes that profit along to parents as a “thank you” for participating. Every time a family buys \$1000 in cards it earns a \$25 tuition voucher. You can purchase these gift cards at the school office anytime the school is open.



Giant A+ Rewards Program: If you shop at Giant grocery stores, please register your bonus card to the school. In 2009 the school earned nearly \$7500 in free money simply through this program. Shopping at Giant has big rewards!



Love to shop at Target? If you have a Target Visa Card, you can register it to MCCS. The school can receive 1% of your Target purchases and .5% of any other purchases you charge to your Target Visa.
