



Dear Parents,

Thank you for your interest in Mount Calvary Christian School. We are pleased to provide to you the enclosed application materials.

Mount Calvary Christian School (MCCS) opened its doors in September 1976 as a ministry of Mount Calvary Church. Many parents at the church were troubled by the education their children were receiving in the public school system. These Christian parents, striving to obey the commands of the Lord to “train up a child in the way he should go” (Proverbs 22:6) and to “bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord” (Ephesians 6:4), became acutely aware of the growing trend of “secular humanism” along with the exclusion of godly training in the public schools. This trend continues to grow stronger.

We had 99 students our first year of operation and over the ensuing years we have seen enrollments of over 400 students. Our program includes preschool grades through the twelfth grade. The majority of our graduates have gone on to college and further study. Our faculty is comprised of 31 certified teachers, all born-again followers of Jesus Christ.

In addition to the strong phonics program in our elementary classes and the college preparatory and general curricula in our secondary program, MCCS offers fine arts instruction (music, art and drama), supported instruction, and Bible teaching for all grades as well as competitive athletics for grades 6 through 12. Character development and training are taught and caught through our integration of Biblical teachings in all subject areas. Our students follow a code of conduct and dress standards, and learn in disciplined, orderly classrooms. We hold accreditations with the Association of Christian Schools International and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools Committee on Institution-Wide Accreditation.

The enrollment process begins when the application and non-refundable application fee per student (please refer to the attached tuition schedule) are returned to our office. A personal interview with parents and prospective students will be scheduled with a member of the administration. Enrollment is not considered complete until this interview is conducted, past school records and enrollment documents are received and any needed testing is performed.

You are always welcome to visit our school, speak with our faculty members and attend our church. We look forward to meeting you personally.

## ADMISSIONS POLICIES

Attendance at Mount Calvary Christian School is a privilege and not a right. If at any time a student's conduct, academic progress or cooperation with the school administration is not acceptable, the school has the right to dismiss the student from Mount Calvary Christian School.

Any exceptions to the following Admissions Policies must be by school trustee approval.

### I. General

1. Parents are strongly encouraged to enroll all their eligible children. This practice fosters unity of effort on the part of all family members and helps promote the best interests of the children, the family and the school.
2. Pre-kindergarten and kindergarten students must be 4 or 5 years old respectively by September 1 for admission.
3. Immunization records must accompany the kindergarten application. Students at all other levels must provide health records from their previous school.
4. The registration fee must accompany a completed written application.
5. All new students are accepted on a nine-week trial basis.
6. If a student is expelled, re-admission must be by written request and school trustee approval.
7. A satisfactory interview must be completed before a student is accepted. At least one parent or guardian must attend the interview.
8. Prospective students in grades 7-12 must complete a separate student application in addition to the family application. The middle/high school student must be interviewed by the supervising principal and give a clear indication of the desire to be at the school.
9. No enrollment is final until a student's transcripts have been received in the school office and all requested forms are completed on file.
10. No student will be enrolled if the family has an unpaid financial obligation at another Christian school.
11. No student may graduate from our high school unless he/she has attended one full school year at Mount Calvary Christian School.
12. Priorities for acceptance are established as follows:  
**Priority I: Current school families, including children of new employees.**  
**Priority II: Members of Mount Calvary Church**  
**Priority III: New families must submit a completed application form. Former school families seeking to return will be considered new families.**  
\*Qualification for these priorities is contingent upon submitting re-enrollment/enrollment forms according to the established deadlines.
13. The school reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not cooperate with the educational process.
14. The school reserves the right to dismiss any family that does not fulfill its obligations as agreed to herein.
15. All prospective students in grades K-12 will be given an entrance test to determine grade placement and to determine if the prospective student fits the educational capabilities of the school. Parents must provide copies of report cards, special testing reports, child study reports, or similar documents upon request of the principal.
16. Serious consideration is given to the academic background of prospective students. Prospective students may be refused admission for any of the following reasons:
  - a. failure in a previous grade
  - b. currently failing in grade, if admission request comes during a school year
  - c. need of special education or having been assigned to special education classes by the previous school
  - d. failure to achieve on the grade level for which admission is being sought
  - e. a reading problem judged severe enough to hamper progress

- f. a poor report card from the previous year
- 17. A student's conduct and disciplinary record will be inspected very carefully before admission. In particular, admission may be refused for any of the following reasons:
  - a. suspension from school
  - b. expulsion from school
  - c. rejection by other Christian schools
  - d. police record
  - e. court probation
  - f. participation in smoking, drinking alcoholic beverages, and misuse of drugs.
- 18. Mount Calvary Christian School admits students of any race, color, national, and ethnic origin, disability or handicap to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin, disability or handicap in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, athletic and other school-administered program.

## **II. Spiritual**

Because our school is thoroughly Christian, we place an emphasis upon spiritual training. Our beliefs are based upon the Holy Bible and it is from God's Word that we derive our standards and teach our students. The school seeks students whose parents are in substantial agreement with our school on spiritual matters and who will manifest a spirit of true cooperation in this area. The school seeks to enroll students who have accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and whose families attend a Protestant, fundamental church.
