



In partnering with parents to educate children academically, physically, socially, and spiritually, we strive to set standards that reflect neatness and modesty, while allowing for personal style and taste. *Students attending school-sponsored activities (afterschool programs, field trips, etc.) must follow the guidelines unless otherwise stated.*

**General Guidelines:**

**Yes:**

- Jeans any color but blue
- Slacks
- Shoes-Athletic, Dress and Casual
- Sandals-Dress and/or Leather

**No:**

- Unnatural hair colors or styles that draw undue attention
- Sweatbands, bandanas, hats, caps, sunglasses or outerwear (coats) in class
- Visible tattoos or body piercings (girl's earrings ok)
- Baggy, sagging or tight clothing
- T-shirts
- Large graphics or wording
- Cargo pants
- Athletic sandals, slides, or rubber/plastic flip flops or shoes with excessive heel height

**Girls:**

**Yes:**

- Skirts/dresses that reach the top of the knee and allow for modesty when seated
- Leggings/Jeggings worn with skirts/dresses/long shirts that reach top of knee
- Mid-calf capris are okay for:
  - -Elementary during 1<sup>st</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> quarters
  - -Middle School/High School all year
- Tops with modest neckline, cover the shoulder, be of sufficient length to cover waistline when sitting as well as with arms raised

**No:**

- Extremes in dress, jewelry, or makeup
- Cleavage, sheer fabrics, visible undergarments including straps
- Shorts or Slits in skirts/dresses above the knee

**Boys:**

**Yes:**

- Hair neat and well groomed, off of ears and collar, bangs above the eyebrows, sideburns neatly trimmed and no longer than bottom of ear, clean shaven
- All collared shirts, Henley's (button and hem), sweaters, ¾ zip shirt or jacket, designer shirt with hoods or hoodies, shirts with small logos.
- MCCS or sports teams sweatshirts (not large designer advertisement)
- Sweatshirts with a school approved shirt underneath
- Pants at waistline with no underclothing showing
- Golf shorts are okay for:
  - Elementary during 1<sup>st</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> quarters
  - Middle School/High School all year

**No:**

- Full zip jackets or sweatshirts with rips/holes
- Chains, necklaces, bracelets, earrings

**Friday and Spirit Day Guidelines:**

**Yes:**

- Blue jeans that fit appropriately and have no rips or tears
- MCCS apparel including long and short sleeved T-shirts
- Sleeved MCCS uniform shirts (baseball, soccer, etc.)

***As a general rule of thumb, if you are in doubt whether or not something follows dress code, don't wear it. Find clothing that clearly fits within the guidelines. Final approval of dress code compliance is up to the school administration's discretion.***
