As we release the initial details about our Phased Opening Plan for Mount Calvary Christian School, we want to update you on the specifics concerning our Cyber School delivery option for the 2020-2021 school year.

Choosing a Cyber Option

If you choose the MCCS Cyber option, you will be learning at home and will not be able to reintegrate back into the classroom until at least January. Under some circumstances, we may allow reintegration, but the move will be permanent and only if there is available space in your student's grade level. Many grade levels are full, with waiting lists, so please do not rely on this possibility. We will be unable to allow students to move back and forth between the cyber and in-school programs or vice versa.

Elementary Cyber with MCCS

Much of the elementary learning will be asynchronous with serious, personal support. Asynchronous means that the teachers will post assignments, coach, and occasionally teach simultaneously with the students in a livestream format. Our cyber school at the elementary level is not a video classroom. Our dedicated, cyber faculty will facilitate social interaction and collaboration between at-home students wherever possible.

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Secondary Cyber with MCCS

Secondary classes will be livestreamed and taught by our secondary faculty. Any student that needs to learn from home will be able to log into class in real-time. Classrooms are equipped with cameras that automatically follow the teacher's movement. The platform we are using will broadcast the image of all at-home students onto a 50" monitor in the classroom so students can interact with the in-person class.
